Private Enrichment Yard Rentals:

- We will be offering the Enrichment Yard for private rentals of 30 minutes at a time. This will only be offered to clients and will only be available on a limited schedule due to classes and such. Get on the schedule and grab your spot before we're full.



Guided Play Sessions

- We will be hosting guided play groups. This means that there will be a trainer or two present to oversee the play and guide the session to help keep everyone relaxed and playing nicely.
